



SEASONAL CONSERVATION AIDE

Description: Spring/Summer position under the supervision of the Operations Supervisor and Ranger/Technician. Position based out of the shop in Wapello, IA. This position can start as early as April and end as late as October. Starting and ending dates are flexible. 40 hour work week with weekends, evenings, and overnight required.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities: *The following duties are normal for this position, but other duties may be required and/or assigned as needed.*

- Assist in park maintenance operations and duties such as mowing, trimming, painting, trail work, collection of garbage and liter pickup.
- Assist in park patrol duties including cleaning restrooms.
- Assist with prescribed burns, as training and timing permits.
- Assist other board staff as requested by the Operations Supervisor or Executive Director.

Salary: \$10 per hour. No benefits, no housing available.

Entry Level Requirements: Must be at least 18 years old. Prefer degree or working toward a degree with major coursework in conservation, natural resources, physical science or park and recreation management. Valid motor vehicle operators' license required.

Knowledge, Skills & Abilities: Must be able to walk over a variety of landscapes and use hands to manipulate hand tools such as chainsaws, shovels and similar tools. May also operate tractors, mowers and other equipment. Must be able to lift up to 50 pounds.
